## **Backyard Safari – Activity Guide**

#### **Materials Needed:**

- Student Activity Page (See Page 2)
- Writing Utensil

## **Vocabulary:**

- Observation the act of watching something attentively; a record or notion of the act
- Habitat an area that provides an animal or plant with adequate food, water, shelter, and living space in a suitable arrangement
- Shelter cover for natal (birth) activity or bedding and protection from weather

#### Steps:

- Go into your backyard, to a public park, or any outdoor areas with trees or plants
- Use the provided worksheet to guide student in looking for animals and animal signs outside
- After observations are collected use the following questions to guide discussion:
  - O What animals did you observe?
  - O What evidence did you find of other animals?
  - O What kinds of foods do these animals eat?
  - O What kind of shelter might these animals find?
  - O Where could these animals get water?
  - O What were the largest and smallest animals you observed?
  - O What was the most surprising observation you made?
